

Exam results 2012

For the second year in a row, 80% of Uffculme Students achieved 5 or more GCSEs at grades A*-C including English & Maths. This is a record for Uffculme and represents a significant achievement. Teachers and pupils worked incredibly hard together and ambitious targets were set for every student. It is a measure of their commitment and high aspirations that many of these targets were exceeded by some considerable margin.

A combination of outstanding teaching, fantastic support from parents and determination on the part of the students secured these exceptional results and has ensured that almost every pupil can pursue their college or training course of their choice. Once again no student left Uffculme with fewer than 3 GCSE passes and 95% had at least 5. 70% of the year group attained at least 1 A/A* grade and 41% attained at least 3 A/A* grades. Nearly 1 in 3 students had at least 5 A and A* passes.
